
Christmas Newsletter 2018

For this we arrange sponsorships to pay the individual school children. Because education is the way out of poverty. Unfortunately, without education and without perspective, the future of women in poverty ends up with often alcoholic men and high birth rates.

This year, we were there ourselves and met our cooperation partner, Florence Ndoodhe, who heads the CEIO (Child Education Initiative Organization) and we are friends together. We were able to visit the first donated children in each school with her. In addition, we had the great privilege to be invited by a mother of a godchild and to know the environment from which the child comes. Poverty has touched us a lot, but so has our gratitude and that unlikely warmth of the heart moves.



We also want to help the children, who are not students but are gifted with craftsmanship. For this purpose, the construction of a vocational school has been started, which is already half finished. There are about 200 children to get the opportunity, the profession, such. As the chef, the carpenter, the craftsman to learn practically and thus the necessary money for a living earn yourself.
